

**STUDENT UNIFORM DRESS CODE
REVISED 2011-2012**

South Beauregard Elementary
Pre-Kindergarten through 5th Grade

(Includes riding the bus to and from school) Uniforms may be purchased at any store but must follow this Beauregard Parish Student Uniform Dress Code

Only clear or mesh book bags are allowed for Pre-K through the 12th grade. Athletic bags are allowed if they are not carried from class to class and will be dropped off at a designated location before school starts and picked up at the end of the school day.

SOLID PURPLE, SOLID GOLD, OR SOLID WHITE

PLAIN SHIRTS AND BLOUSED

Acceptable

Plain Polo Style

Collared, two or three button knit

Plain Oxford Cloth or Plain Dress Shirt

Style, Collared, Button-up

Plain Turtlenecks(traditional/mock)

Not Acceptable

Baseball Jersey Style

Sleeveless Shirts and Blouses

Henley Shirts

V-Neck Pullovers

Crew Necks

Hunting Style Shirts

Shirts and Blouses too short to remain tucked in

Any Other Style

- Shirts and blouses shall be buttoned and long enough to remain tucked in at the waist.
- Solid plain white or school uniform colored short sleeved undershirt can be worn under acceptable uniform shirts.
- Undershirt sleeves may not extend longer than outer shirt.

SWEATERS, VESTS (Without Hoods, Logos, Emblems or Brand Names)

Acceptable

All worn with acceptable Collared Shirt

All no longer than hip length nor shorter than waist length

Solid Navy Blue, White, or Khaki

Not Acceptable

Fleece Vests

Hunting Style Vests

Any Other Styles

COATS AND JACKETS

Acceptable

All worn with acceptable shirt/blouse

Color not mandated – unless pullovers

Waist length to three quarters length

Must be long sleeved

Button, snap or zip from top to bottom

Bottom must be banded or straight

Not Acceptable

Trench Coats, Dusters, etc.

Any other style

PULLOVERS (With or Without Hoods)

Acceptable

All worn with acceptable collared shirt

Must be in school colors or uniform dress code colors, with or without a school logo

Administrators are authorized to use their discretion in determining extremes in styles of dress and grooming and what is appropriate and suitable for school wear.

OTHER GARMENTS: Solid Khaki/Navy Blue

No jean (khaki or any other color), Parachute, Nylon or stretch Materials such as Knit, Spandex, etc.

PANTS/TROUSERS

Acceptable

Traditional Style
Plain or Pleated Front
Hemmed
Regular Ankle Length
Capri Pants
Cropped Pants

Not Acceptable

Jeans (Any Color)
Overalls or Carpenter
Cargo or Wide Leg
Hip Huggers
Bell Bottoms/Flair Legs
Any Other Styles

WALKING SHORTS AND SKORTS

Acceptable

Knee Length or Longer
Hemmed

Not Acceptable

Overalls or Carpenter
Cargo or Wide Leg
Any Other Styles

SKIRTS & JUMPERS

Acceptable

Knee Length or Longer
Slits Knee Length or Below

Not Acceptable

Slits Above the Knee
Cargo Style Pockets
Any Other Style

Loops Require Belts (Traditional Style) at All Times Except Pre-k and Kindergarten

BELT COLORS: Black, Navy, Brown, Khaki or White

ACCEPTABLE

SOCKS OR STOCKINGS/HOSE MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

Socks – Solid Navy, White, Black, or Khaki
Stockings/Hose – Solid Navy, White, Black, or Sheer Skin Tone

SHOES

Appropriate footwear with backs or straps (no skate shoes)
Must be worn at all times during the school day
Shoes with laces shall be kept tied at all times

Clothing that has been altered by cutting, ripping, fraying from the original state is not allowed.

All clothing appropriately sized. All clothing plain, without brand names, brand emblems or logos showing outwardly (except for coats and jackets). Example: The brand name Duckhead is not to appear on the front or back of the clothing except for coats and jackets.
